Four nights to enjoy this picturesque part of the South. With the Mendips, Quantock and Brendon Hills to explore, interesting motoring is assured.




The Event Base Hotel is the DoubleTree, Hilton Cadbury House A 4* Hotel at Yatton, South of Bristol

This is a lovely, stylish and homely 4* boutique hotel in the South-West of the UK with over 200 years' worth of history. With large grounds and a versatile décor, it offers a place for everyone during their stay here. Dating back to the late 1700's - the house and grounds lived in by private residents, then between the years of 1939 – 1955 it became a boys prep school called St David's. Later, in World War II, the main entrance was used as an air raid shelter whilst remaining a school - with some of the pupils saying they saw the ghost of a little girl walking down the stairs...With this being the only hotel on this trip – we wanted to make it an interesting one. So, book your place today and perhaps you will make friends with the little girl on the staircase!

Monday 25th | Cheddar Gorge & Wells

Following on from the ghost theme of the hotel, some interesting motoring through Cheddar Gorge for the first day. Near it's namesake village, the village of Cheddar – the gorge is the site of the Cheddar show caves. Here you can meet 'Cheddar Man' a 9,000 year old skeleton found in 1903! We will then take a trip through the hills to Wells and its fabulous Cathedral.

Wells is a medieval city that is resting in the arm of the southern side of the Mendip Hills The history of Wells goes back to Roman times where it is believed there was a settlement, probably because of the springs that bubble up in the area – hence the name Wells!



Tuesday 26th | Watchet and Dunster Visits

For our second day a drive alongside the Quantock Hills tot Watchet for coffee. Then on the coast road via Blue Anchor to Dunster village and its Castle. Watchet was used by Alfred the Great as he fended off Vikings in the 10th Century and was also, during this time, known for making coins! It is believed that Watchet got it's name from the word 'wacet' that is found in the blue dye in the cliffs but more likely, it came from what they would call the area in 918 – 'Waeced' which literally means 'below or under the wood'. At Dunster we see another medieval village with a fairy-tale castle perched at the top of the hill. Dunster castle has been used throughout the years and was first granted to the French De Mohun family by William the Conqueror as a gift for service following his victory at the Battle of Hastings in 1066! Homeward will be via the Brendon Hills, which will be a first for most of us!



Wednesday 27th | Haynes Motor Museum Coffee and Visit

"Preservation by operation is key to the care of the collection" – in other words "get those cars out and keep em' moving!"

Finally, our last day we visit the Haynes International Motor Museum in Sparkford. Created by John Haynes, thanks to his love of motoring vehicles – the museum is based on a World War II American munitions dump! With it big enough to hold all of Mr. Haynes many vehicles and automobile paraphernalia it was the perfect place for him to set up.

The museum never stands still and is always growing in collection, direction and improving its customer experience! With many of us having classic cars and motor vehicles in common with what's in the Museum, this should be a great trip to end this weekend!

BOOKING CONDITIONS

1. **HOTELS:** All reservations are made on a first come basis. If the room that you request is not available then you will be contacted and offered alternative arrangements.
2. **YOUR EVENT CONTRACT:** At the time of asking for a booking to be made on your behalf, you must complete and sign a booking form agreeing to accept these booking conditions. Your contract is entered into on the terms and conditions of these booking conditions and the completed booking form must be received accompanied by the appropriate deposit or full payment, at which time, subject to availability of the particular event, your contract with us is made.
3. **DEPOSITS AND PAYMENT:** No booking can be accepted unless accompanied by a deposit of £150 per person. This is your only commitment until 10 weeks before the Event. Payment of the balance remaining, after deducting the deposit from the total cost of the event as expressed in our confirmation/invoice, will be due then without further notice. If the final payment is not received by that due date, ERL reserves the right to treat your booking as cancelled and you could be liable to pay cancellation charges in accordance with the section below entitled cancellations.
4. **IF YOU CHANGE YOUR BOOKING:** If you want to change any of the arrangements specified on your Booking Confirmation/Invoice, we will do all we can to accommodate your new requirements. An alteration fee of £40 per booking will be charged for any such change to cover administration costs, except within 8 weeks of departure when the change will be treated as a cancellation (see section 8 below) and not as an alteration.
